

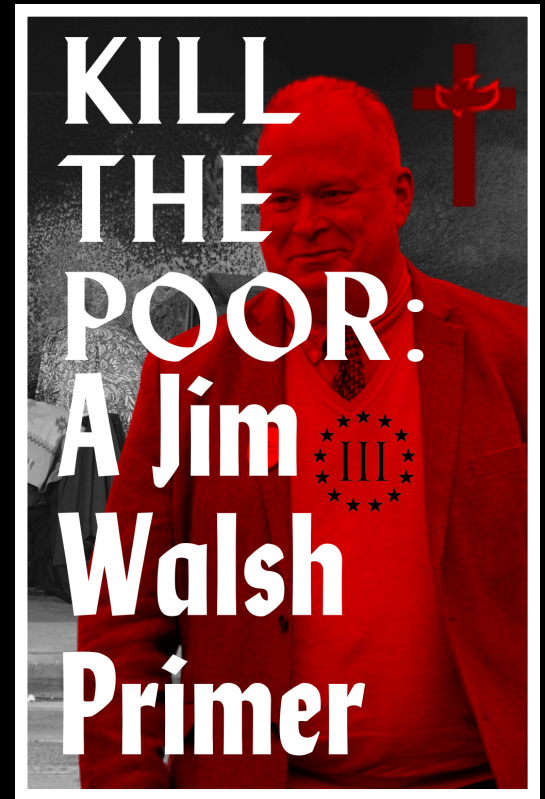

The last few weeks in town have been marked by significant developments, but not without controversy. The Westport Golf Links project, a \$30 million investment, has raised many eyebrows. While it promises to revitalize Westport Light State Park with a new golf course, trails, and amenities, concerns about the environmental impact are mounting. Critics argue that the project could disrupt wetlands and rare habitats, despite assurances of using eco-friendly practices. The debate highlights the tension between economic development and environmental preservation, with many questioning whether the promised benefits justify the potential ecological damage.

Similarly, the Port of Grays Harbor and AGP's Terminal 4 Expansion & Redevelopment Project has sparked mixed reactions. This ambitious project, the largest infrastructure endeavor the Port has undertaken, aims to enhance rail infrastructure and construct a new commodity export facility. However, the push for industrial growth raises concerns about the long-term environmental impact and the true economic benefits to the local community. Critics emphasize that while job creation is touted, the potential for increased pollution and environmental degradation cannot be ignored. These projects reflect the broader struggle to balance economic aspirations with environmental responsibility, leaving many in the community skeptical about whether the costs will outweigh the benefits. On the law enforcement front, recent activities have drawn everyone's thoughts to the drug trade yet again. In Hoquiam, Officer Juan Martinez's arrest of a subject with a misdemeanor warrant involved the use of narcotics detection K9 Niko, leading to further investigation based on drug paraphernalia. This has raised concerns about the broader implications of such proactive policing strategies. Similarly, in Aberdeen, the arrest of a 42-year-old resident found passed out in a vehicle led to a search revealing drugs and a loaded pistol. Given the prevalence of low level drug busts and arrests of users these incidents highlight issues related to the criminalization of drug users and the potential for over-policing, particularly among vulnerable populations.

Politically, the Washington state GOP has claimed that the state did not shift leftward in the recent election, contrary to early media reports. They argue for a return to in-person voting to avoid premature conclusions. "People who know Washington state politics know not to read major conclusions in preliminary results," said Washington State Republican Party (WAGOP) Chairman and Aberdeen state Rep. Jim Walsh. "Our 100% mail-in voting system is slow. We wait days, even weeks, before we know for certain what the final results will be. So was the case this time, as media outlets jumped to wrong conclusions. This is just one reason the WAGOP would like to see a return to in-person, same-day voting. We'd be less prone to early media reports that turn out to be false."

First of all, fuck you Jim Walsh. Your endless tirades against the poor and vulnerable are an embarrassment to our community. You do not represent anything but the worst of us; the entrenched powers, and the status quo. Your comments belie your true intentions. That you desire less people voting. Part of your ultra conservative worldview includes only certain segments of society having any say in the direction of their future. That doesn't include poor people, BIPOC people, LGBTQ2IAX+ beings, none of that. Just white Christian patriots. Your death cult is ruining and costing real lives in our community, as you live up on the hill in your mansion. We will stand it no longer. Respect existence, or expect resistance. We have spent years mapping out your networks, learning your boundaries and strategies, detailing your weaknesses and vulnerabilities. Check out our new zine "Kill The Poor: A Jim Walsh Primer" for a good starting place on understanding where this man is coming from.



Secondly, where to start with these fucking cops?! The fear we published about previously that all the new crop of younger officer would be more than happy to arrest unhoused people, drug users, and the disabled for merely just existing. Some might claim that this is the best way to get people help, to that we say where is your evidence. All the evidence we have ever seen demonstrates that housing first is the best and most efficient model for getting people back to a healthy place in their lives. The methods being used to arrest and prosecute people for using drugs is beyond antiquated. It is frankly embarrassing to see. Yet we here at Sabot Media are aware that is but a small part of the grander plan to gentrify this area and push out the poor, the unhoused, the addicted, the disabled, and the queer. Its not really a hidden agenda at this point, as the last wave of recent wins for the far right, from the election to Grants Pass, pushes them to be more and more open in their blood lust. They will refuse another year of cold weather shelter, but will certainly continue to arrest people for these crimes of poverty throughout this cold winter.

Finally, as for the coming infrastructure projects, they too play into this conception of gentrifying the Harbor into a destination for the ultra wealthy to have their vacations, their short term rentals, their demands for the "cleansing" of this county. Every story here can be seen as parts of a greater whole if you have been following along. The rich get new golf courses, the environment suffers further degradation. The rich get second and third houses, the poor suffer on the streets. All the while those in positions of power blame more and more on the symptoms of poverty and further criminalize our lives. Pushing the poor into cells that can be used to force us into labor for slave wages. This is the grand vision. If we want to avoid this future it is far past time to stand up and stop it from happening. No one is coming to save us, there is no electoral solution. Us organizing in our communities, aiding each other through this hard time, and caring for each other deeply is the only solution. Export facilities, golf courses, and empires all crumble with time, but our solidarity will see us through to the other side.
